

HISTORY OF M. H. S.

Looking over the years since the founding of McAlester City School System, increased growth is shown. The present location of the high school has always been known as "High School Hill" except for the two years after the fire, during which time the present building was erected.

William Gay, who had that same year moved here, founded the first public school of McAlester. The only means of education previously, was a few subscription schools and private tutors, both of which were costly.

Mr. Gay, noticing people's lack of education, set out to classify students for school; students were soon enrolled in a small wooden structure, very similar to a barn, the first McAlester High School. From this crude forerunner of the present High School that the classes of 1903, 1905, 1906, and 1907 graduated.

The taxpayers of the city who maintained the school in 1919 built a more modern high school.

HISTORY OF THE BUFFALO HEAD

In giving the history of the buffalo head, I believe it would be best to first tell the history of the adoption of the "Buffalo" as school name for its athletic teams.

The athletic teams of MHS were first called the "Convicts", because of the prison located in McAlester, but this was no complimentary to the school so it was dropped and for a time the teams were nicknamed for the coaches. For instance, while Runt Ramsey was coach we were called the "Runts" and during the time Doc Ruppert was coach were known as the "Little Docs".

After Ruppert left Koote Pyle, the faculty and student body got together and decided to adopt a permanent school name. They chose the "Buffalo" as the animal best describing its athletic teams and school spirit.

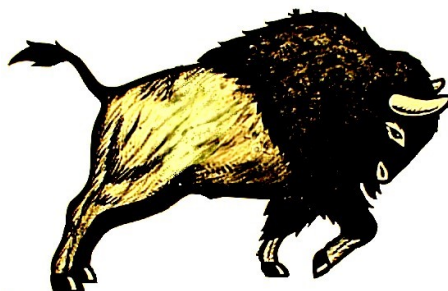
The class of 1928 not only was responsible for the name chosen, but also gave us the head now hanging in this auditorium as a permanent symbol.

It has been hard to get much information, but I believe this head was purchased from a firm in Oklahoma City, for \$65.00 and was presented to the school by Mr. John Tua, who now lives in McAlester.

It seems that this head was valued for much more than the class of 1928 paid, but as it was to be used by the school as a permanent trophy a liberal discount was given.

Every MHS student should be proud of the name "Buffalo" because it is a symbol of strength, endurance, and persistence, which is characteristic of the students and athletic teams of McAlester High School.

In 1993, the MHS student body voted to have an official buffalo because every athletic team and organization was using a different buffalo and the student body wanted to have an official buffalo. The student body voted and Jade Oldhom with signs by Jade drew up the official buffalo.



THE ORIGIN OF THE BLACK AND GOLD

Public schools in McAlester were a little over 10 years old in 1911, when the student body decided that they needed permanent school colors. During that year, a committee was formed with the task of making recommendations for the school colors. The committee chose the colors black and gold. The committee chose black and gold. No one knows the exact reason for choosing these colors, but it seems that this was a sound choice, for the black could well represent the staff of life for the McAlester area, its coal, and the gold, its value to the inhabitants of the town.

ORIGIN OF THE DANCING RABBIT

Prior to the enactment of the familiar Dancing Rabbit Treaty, which was made by the Federal Government on September 15, 1830, the Choctaw Indians resided in Mississippi. In the Dancing Rabbit Treaty, the United States government, under the personal supervision of the President, granted a portion of the land west of the Mississippi River to the Choctaw and Creek Indians "to them and their descendants, to ensure to them while they shall exist as a nation, and live on it." When Mr. Tyler assumed the duties of the President, he fulfilled the conditions of this treaty by issuing a patent to the Choctaw Nation on March 23, 1842, which gave them possession of that part of Oklahoma known as the Choctaw Nation. The title to all land upon which our magnificent High School building stands, rests upon the Dancing Rabbit Treaty, and for this reason we have seen fit to give the name "Dancing Rabbit" to our Annual.

THE ORIGIN OF YANNUSH

In the year 1938, there were two pep clubs at McAlester High School, the Peppers, organized in 1925, and the Knockouts, in 1928. Both were begun for the purpose of keeping up the pep of the school. Membership however was limited to 24 girls in the Peppers, and 30 girls in the Knockouts. As a result, many girls were not admitted to the ranks of the two clubs therefore in 1938, a pep club was formed that was open to ever girl of the school. The newly formed pep club took in name, Yannush, which is Choctaw for "Little Buffalo". Our present day pep squad still bears this name.

THE ORIGIN OF THE WOW - WOWS

In 1923, McAlester High School at last succeeded in organizing an "honest to goodness", live wire pep club. Credit for this largely due to Jap Haskell and Irvin Gladstein, who did much to make it possible. Twelve boys, who had been prominent as "pep" leaders in the past, were selected, and the club was organized. The WOW-WOWs are characterized by co-operations and pep, and quickly became the best known organization in the school. Their purpose was to instill greater interest in the athletic activities of McAlester High. Needless to say, the club succeeded beyond its hopes, and the basketball games there year were attended by the largest and most enthusiastic crowds the school has ever known. There they made the games doubly interesting by their clever entertainments between halves, which added much interest to the game. Though organized late in the year, for temporary purposes, the club grew to such popularity that it promises to become a permanent organization at McAlester High.

THE ORIGIN OF THE SENIOR SIRENS

In the fall of 1987, several students of Kathy Winn's senior English class approached her about sponsoring a club, which would act as a spirit group. McAlester didn't have any pep clubs at that time, and the students were interested in actively supporting the football team. During the season, they made signs showing support, and the made the team "goodies" which were distributed on game day. At the games, they sat together, waved a flag that they had made in the school colors, yelled, and cheered the

team to victory. The name was chosen because the club was limited to senior girls. The first year there were twenty members and Kim Allford was the president.

SCHOOL CREED

FOOTBALL QUEENS

1928-29 For the first time in the history of M.H.S. a football queen was elected. The football boys nominated two girls from the two pep clubs. Thelma Jo Cesar, Na Kaut, and Elizabeth Thaxton, Pepper, were chosen. The contest lasted for a week and ended on Friday of the McAlester-Sapulpa game.

A parade was formed, and the two nominees led, riding in a car decorated with the school colors. The pep clubs followed with the class stunts, and the student body of Junior High on a fire truck was last. The winner was not announced until a few minutes before the half ended.

Thelma Jo Cesar won by a small majority and was crowned between halves by the three pep clubs. Elmore Gill, president of the Wow-Wows, escorted her to the center of the field, where he placed the crown on her head. Yells led by Margaret Kaeiser, student body yell leader, followed.

The student body elected the queen by voting with pennies, which were dropped in the jar for the respective candidates. The freshman class, who were making money for the penny carnival, sponsored the contest.

Both the pep clubs as well as the entire student body showed a great deal of interest and worked hard to put their candidate over.
